Spending time by the water can be fun and relaxing, but it can also be dangerous.



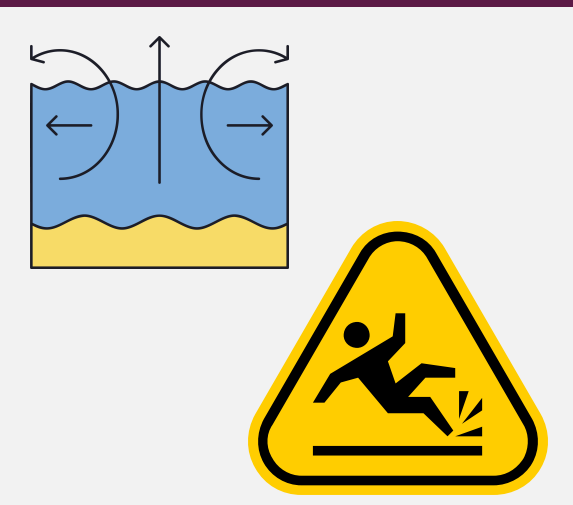
Drowning is a serious risk when spending time in or around a body of water.



Bodies of water can include pools, lakes, rivers, or the ocean.



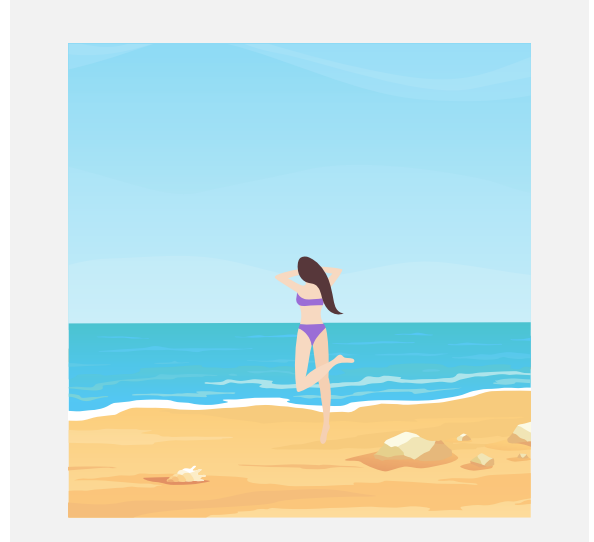
When I'm near a body of water, I should check for dangers, such as deep water, strong currents, or slippery surfaces.
