- While awaiting your test results, you AND all members of your household should selfquarantine.
- If you test positive, self-isolate until: Fever free and without infectious symptoms (cough most prominently) for at least 72 hours without use of antifever or other symptom management medications and 10 days have passed since symptoms began.

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
